Obtaining Certificates of Insurance from **ALL** of your Participants, performers or vendors, is imperative to the risk management of your show. In addition to the items below, be sure each Certificate also lists the following information:

Insurance Company

Effective Dates of Coverage
Limits of Liability
Issue Date of Certificate (this date should be no more than 60 days prior to the event)
Activity and Location being covered

For aircraft performers, be sure Certificates Include:

Aircraft use in event
Specific Use of Aircraft (such as Airshows for Hire, Rides, Parachuting, Static Displays, Fly-Bys, etc)
Names of all approved pilots
Limit of Liability: (suggested minimum)
\$1,000,000 each occurrence, Bodily Injury and Property Damage
Unacceptable: \$1,000,000 each occurrence with a sub-limit of
\$ 100,000 per "person" bodily injury
if performer is giving rides. the Airshow needs to be added as an Additional Insured to the performer's policy

For participants other than aircraft (including Jet Cars). Certificates need to include:

For Parachute Jump Teams:

Certificates from junipers showing they have Third Party Liability
